



College Scholarship Guidelines – 2017

High school seniors graduating in 2017 are eligible to receive a \$1,000 college scholarship from the Michael Odermann Memorial Scholarship Pheasant Hunt. There will be two scholarships available to seniors who submit an essay that meets the criteria.

Applicant Criteria

- ❖ Student must be enrolled in a western North Dakota high school and be an active participant in one Fine Art and one Athletic co-curricular activity as a senior.
- ❖ Student must have maintained a GPA of 2.5 (on a 4 point scale) or better throughout high school
- ❖ To qualify for this competitive scholarship, a student must submit a 1-3 page essay (minimum 500 words).
- ❖ Essays must be submitted by **April 25, 2017**.
- ❖ Winners will be notified by letter.
- ❖ The Michael Odermann Memorial Scholarship Fund will write two checks to college of choice in which the winner is enrolled. Checks will be disbursed and applied as follows:
 - \$500 check for 2017 fall semester
 - \$500 check for 2018 spring semester
- ❖ A committee will review all essays and select the scholarship winners.
