Eligibility Requirements:

1. Students must demonstrate leadership skills and the motivation to participate in extracurricular activities.
2. Students must demonstrate a commitment to and passion for conservations and improvement of wildlife habitat.
3. Students must submit an autobiography and essay. (See application for details)
4. High School Seniors must submit complete application and attachments to the local Pheasants Forever Chapter by May 1st, 2017.

Selection Process:

- Local chapter will work in cooperation with schools to notify winner.

Disbursement of Funds:

The local chapter will work with the student to determine when the check is issued. This will ensure the greatest benefit to the recipient and avoid violation of eligibility requirements.
