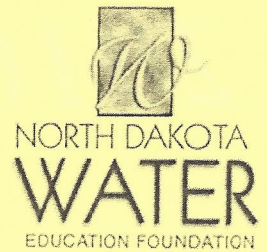

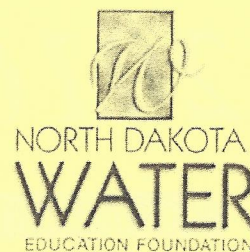

BACKGROUND INFORMATION

The Dushinske & Jamison Water Resources Scholarship Endowment was established by the North Dakota Water Education Foundation (NDWEF) within the North Dakota Community Foundation in memory of Russ Dushinske and Warren Jamison and their distinguished service, dedicated leadership and life-long devotion to water development in North Dakota.

SCHOLARSHIPS

Income from the Dushinske & Jamison Water Resources Scholarship Endowment provides scholarships to two deserving North Dakota students. **Two \$1,500 scholarships** will be awarded to one female and one male. Scholarship recipients must attend a North Dakota college or university and preference will be given to, but not limited to, students studying water-related fields and students whose families have taken an active role in North Dakota water resource management.

Scholarship recipients are required to attend the Annual North Dakota Water Convention Awards Banquet on Dec. 8, 2016 to read the winning essays.

APPLICATION PROCESS

Applications for the Dushinske & Jamison Water Resources Scholarship must be postmarked no later than April 1. The NDWEF will notify the scholarship recipients by May 1. Scholarship checks will be mailed to the college or university the student is attending at the beginning of the spring semester. **Recipients are required to attend the banquet on Dec. 8, 2016 to receive their scholarships.**
